### **PURPOSE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS**

#### **PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO NGC REGULATIONS 23.020, 23.025, AND 23.050**

**PURPOSE:** To add definitions for "card game progressive," "card game promotional pool," and "card game promotional rake-off" as specifically applicable to card games; to clarify drop box procedures also include other requirements; to add requirements related to promotional drop boxes; to add requirements regarding promotional rake-offs; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.

#### **PROPOSED REPEAL OF NGC REGULATION 1.150**

**PURPOSE:** To repeal NGC Regulation 1.150 to eliminate redundancy with Regulation 23; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate this stated purpose.

#### **PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO NGC REGULATION 5.110**

**PURPOSE:** To clarify the scope of "progressive payoff schedule" within NGC Regulation 5.110; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate this stated purpose.

**PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO NGC REGULATION 5A.020**

**PURPOSE:** To add definitions for “pot,” “interactive gaming promotional pool,” “interactive gaming promotional rake-off,” and “rake-off” as specifically applicable to interactive gaming card games; to clarify the scope of “progressive payoff schedule” within NGC Regulation 5A.145; and to take such additional action as may be necessary and proper to effectuate these stated purposes.
