

# **RULES OF PLAY**

### **Game Description**

*Blackjack Squeeze* is an optional bonus and progressive wager for standard Blackjack and Blackjack-variant games and can be played with 1-8 standard, 52-card decks. The object of *Blackjack Squeeze* is for the dealer's up-card to rank between the player's first two cards. The outcome of *Blackjack Squeeze* is not dependent on the base game's outcome.

#### **Rules of Play**

- 1. To begin each round, players must place a standard base game wager and may place any available optional bonus wagers.
- After all wagers have been placed, two cards are dealt to each player, face-up, and two cards are dealt to the dealer, one face-up and one face-down, as per standard blackjack dealing procedures.
- 3. The dealer then follows house procedures to reconcile the *Blackjack Squeeze* wagers based on the player's first two cards and the dealer's up-card.
  - a. Blackjack Squeeze wagers are paid according to the corresponding paytable(s) in Appendix A.
  - b. *Blackjack Squeeze Progressive* wagers are paid according to the corresponding paytable(s) in Appendix B.
  - c. Blackjack Squeeze Dynamic Progressive wagers are paid according to the corresponding paytable(s) in Appendix C.
- 4. The primary game is now played to completion.

### Appendix A

### Blackjack Squeeze

| Hand                    | PT-FLT-SQZ-01 | PT-FLT-SQZ-02 |
|-------------------------|---------------|---------------|
| Suited Straight Squeeze | 100           | 100           |
| Straight Squeeze        | 10            | 20            |
| Same Color Squeeze      | 5             | 3             |
| Any Squeeze             | 1             | 1             |

#### **Notes**

- 1. All pays are "to 1."
- 2. Only the highest qualifying hand is paid.
- 3. Ace is always high.
- 4. *Squeeze* refers to the 3-card hand, formed from the player's first two cards and the dealer's up-card, where the dealer's up-card ranks between the player's first two cards.
- 5. Suited Straight Squeeze refers to three cards in consecutive rank order, all the same suit, and where the dealer's up-card ranks between the player's first two cards.
- 6. *Straight Squeeze* refers to three cards in consecutive rank order, regardless of suit, and where the dealer's card ranks between the player's first two cards.
- 7. Same Color Squeeze refers to three cards of the same color, all red and or all black, and where the dealer's up-card ranks between the player's first two cards.
- 8. Casino operators may post a maximum aggregate amount payable per round or per hand.

#### **Notes**

- 1. All pays are "for 1." The progressive wager is not returned.
- 2. Only the highest qualifying hand is paid.
- 3. Ace is always high.
- 4. *Squeeze* refers to the 3-card hand, formed from the player's first two cards and the dealer's up-card, where the dealer's up-card ranks between the player's first two cards.
- 5. *Mini Royal Squeeze* refers to the 3-card hand, where the player's first two cards are a Suited Ace Queen and the dealer's up-card is a King of the same suit.
- 6. *Mini Royal Squeeze (Suit Specific)* refers to the 3-card hand, where the player's first two cards are a Suited Ace Queen and the dealer's up-card is a King, all in the suit selected by the operator.
- 7. Suited Straight Squeeze refers to three cards in consecutive rank order, all the same suit, and where the dealer's up-card ranks between the player's first two cards.
- 8. *Straight Squeeze* refers to three cards in consecutive rank order, regardless of suit, and where the dealer's card ranks between the player's first two cards.
- 9. Same Color Squeeze refers to three cards of the same color, all red and or all black, and where the dealer's up-card ranks between the player's first two cards.
- 10. Suit Specific refers to the suit selected by the operator and displayed on the corresponding paytable.
- 11. The a/b configuration options are as follows:
  - a. The "a" option uses the fixed reseed to reset the jackpot.
  - b. The "b" option uses a reserve percentage to reset the jackpot.
- 12. The paytables are based on a \$1 wager. If the progressive is configured with a different base wager amount, the seed/reseed and pays should be multiplied accordingly.


#### **Notes**

- 1. All pays are "for 1." The progressive wager is not returned.
- 2. Only the highest qualifying hand is paid, even if a higher-paying, but lower-ranking hand can be achieved.
- 3. Each round, one to three of the four fixed-pay hands will be randomly selected, and their default pays will be replaced with one of their ten Dynamic pay options. Dynamic pays will be reset to default after each round.
- 4. Ace is always high.
- 5. *Squeeze* refers to the 3-card hand, formed from the player's first two cards and the dealer's up-card, where the dealer's up-card ranks between the player's first two cards.
- 6. *Mini Royal Squeeze* refers to the 3-card hand, where the player's first two cards are a Suited Ace Queen and the dealer's up-card is a King of the same suit.
- 7. *Mini Royal Squeeze (Suit Specific)* refers to the 3-card hand, where the player's first two cards are a Suited Ace Queen and the dealer's up-card is a King, all in the suit selected by the operator.
- 8. Suited Straight Squeeze refers to three cards in consecutive rank order, all the same suit, and where the dealer's up-card ranks between the player's first two cards.
- 9. *Straight Squeeze* refers to three cards in consecutive rank order, regardless of suit, and where the dealer's card ranks between the player's first two cards.
- 10. Same Color Squeeze refers to three cards of the same color, all red and or all black, and where the dealer's up-card ranks between the player's first two cards.
- 11. Suit Specific refers to the suit selected by the operator and displayed on the corresponding paytable.
- 12. The a/b configuration options are as follows:
  - a. The "a" option uses a fixed reseed to reset the jackpot.
  - b. The "b" option uses a reserve percentage to reset the jackpot.
- 13. The paytables are based on a \$1 wager. If the progressive is configured with a different base wager amount, the seed/reseed, pays, and Dynamic Pays should be multiplied accordingly.
